

COORDINATING WITH SENATE REPUBLICANS

Purpose: As the minority party in Congress and in the absence of GOP control of the Executive Branch, it is important to maintain unity and consistency of message among House and Senate Republicans.

Meetings:

- Joint leadership meetings will be held monthly or at the call of the Leaders, to coordinate legislation and the Republican message between the House and Senate.
- Joint ranking member meetings will be held as needed to coordinate committee action in the House and Senate. This may include joint Leaders' task force meetings as well.
- The House and Senate Republican Leaders, along with the Republican Governors are working with teams of private sector experts to provide timely analyses to the leadership and key committees. Along with the RNC, they may help organize issue hearings across the country.
